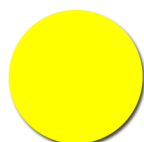

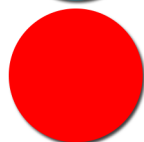
Interleaved spectrum available for Wireless Microphones & IEMs on a special license basis.



Channels 38 is available for wireless microphones and IEMs on a shared license basis, Frequencies 823 - 832MHz are also included inside the UHF shared license.



Channel 70 is available as a license free band. Only 2MHz bandwidth is available.



Channels 61-69 are not available for use by wireless microphones & IEMs except frequencies 823-832MHz which are part of the UHF shared license.



To put this in simple terms from the chart on the other side of this sheet. If you purchase a Channel 70 product (863-865 MHz) YOU DO NOT NEED A LICENCE. This is ideal for users using up to four microphones at the same time and have no other users of microphones or devices on Channel 70 in the vicinity.

To have a system where you can use Multiple microphones you need to purchase a system that uses 606.500 - 613.500 MHz (CH38) or 823-832MHz (Part of CH-65 and part of CH66) or 614-681MHz (interleave). JTS produce systems that use these frequencies, these require a licence to operate in the UK.

Please Note - It is illegal to operate Radio Microphones or IEM system equipment within the UK on ANY Frequencies other than 863-865MHz WITHOUT a License. For ALL Licensing requirements please contact Ofcom via the URL link below
